**CSIP UPDATE**

- Dr. Knight's latest visit was discussed. He considers us to be very much on track to bring scores up in needed areas.
- Use of the Corrective Reading program was also reviewed as to its role in helping our reading scores.
- Possible district-wide literacy program is in the works and will involve a professional day this summer.
- Math groups in 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade are working hard.
- Sunshine groups in the 8<sup>th</sup> grade are also up and going two days per week.
- We are presently using 20 minutes of morning time to jump start the day or for ORQ practice. The morning announcements are being shown at lunch. Ms.Cahoe and the 8<sup>th</sup> grade students are doing a great job with it and want to start an activity class of 8-10 students to help produce shows.
- Channel One is being shown during lunch with modest success.
- The possibility of finding a uniform district approach to answering ORQ's was discussed. It was discussed that the pros and cons of making a unified district approach to ORQ's needs to be addressed.

## **POLICY REVIEW**

1. The assigned policy review of a curriculum aligned to state standards was agreed upon to be a simple statement regarding curriculum maps and their application.
2. The committee decided that the March meeting should involve reviewing and possibly creating a policy regarding entry into and exiting the A-school program. The need to clarify those parameters was seen as critical to successful transitions for our students. Mr. Farmer and Ms. Fahling will be invited to that meeting.
3. The special education collaboration/resource configuration was also explained to the committee as it applies to our special needs students who are considered A-school candidates.
4. The Black History Month assemblies were discussed.
5. Quick rewards for students with good effort or good behavior was discussed by the group.
